V. STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING

1. Approval of the scholarship is contingent upon:
 - a) The endorsement of the applicant and financial support by the home conference.
 - b) The commitment of the applicant to return after studies to serve the home church/conference for three years.
 - c) The endorsement of the applicant by the Global Scholarship Committee.
 - d) The availability of scholarship funds to the Global Scholarship Committee.
2. The scholarship will be awarded contingent upon the full-time registration of the student in the school and approval by the Global Scholarship Committee of the program once it is determined.
3. The scholarship is granted for one year and is renewable a year at a time for a maximum of three years.
4. The Global Scholarship Committee will require annual progress reports from student, school, and conference prior to renewing the scholarship.
5. Students who have not yet studied in an Anabaptist or Mennonite school, and are not applying for study at such a school, will be required to read 500 pages annually in Anabaptist/Mennonite studies, and write a brief report.
